KAREN BASS VICTORY IS LABOR'S VICTORY

- KAREN WON BECAUSE OF SUPPORT FROM THE LOS ANGELES LABOR MOVEMENT
- OUTSPENT BY 11 TO 1 IN MOST EXPENSIVE MAYORAL CAMPAIGN IN THE COUNTRY EVER
- FIRST WOMAN IN 241 YEAR HISTORY OF LOS ANGELES, AND FIRST WOMAN OF COLOR
- OPPORTUNITY TO FORGE A NEW COALITION IN LOS ANGELES WITH LABOR, WOMEN, COMMUNITIES OF COLOR, YOUTH, AROUND ECONOMIC AND RACIAL JUSTICE
- FOCUS ON 40,000 HOMELESS IN L.A. LINKS ECONOMIC INEQUALITY, RACIAL JUSTICE, LIVING WAGE JOBS, UNION CONSTRUCTION, COMMUNITY ORGANIZING

- FOUNDED THE LOS ANGELES BLACK WORKER CENTER, WHICH HAS INSPIRED 17 BLACK WORKER CENTERS NATIONWIDE, INCLUDING RIVERSIDE AND SAN DIEGO
- BUILT ALLIANCES BETWEEN CONSTRUCTION UNIONS AND THE BLACK COMMUNITY, AND PLA AND LOCAL HIRE POLICIES
- ADVANCED WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT TO ADDRESS THE BLACK JOB CRISIS
- THE ONLY BLACK WOMAN IN THE CALIFORNIA STATE SENATE

- YVONNE IS THE FIRST BLACK WOMAN TO LEAD THE L.A. COUNTY FEDERATION OF LABOR
- ELECTED UNANIMOUSLY IN A POWERFUL SHOW OF LABOR UNITY
- HAS DEDICATED HER LIFE TO THE LABOR MOVEMENT, AND HAS WORKED FOR CWA, AFSCME, AFGE, AND THE AFL-CIO
- WORKED WITH THE UCLA LABOR CENTER TO FACILITATE HER FIRST STRATEGIC PLANNING RETREAT FOR THE LA COUNTY FED STAFF

48,000 UC GRADUATE STUDENT WORKERS WIN STRIKE



VICTORY FOR LABOR, VICTORY FOR HIGHER EDUCATION

- LARGEST STRIKE IN HIGHER EDUCATION HISTORY
- FIRST UNION AND FIRST STRIKE FOR VAST MAJORITY OF YOUNG WORKERS
- STRENGTHENED UNION CONSCIOUSNESS AMONG NEW GENERATION OF WORKERS
- ALL 10 UC CAMPUSES MOBILIZED IN UNPRECEDENTED SHOW OF SOLIDARITY
- HUGE CONTRACT VICTORY 46% WAGE INCREASE
- BODES WELL FOR HIGHER EDUCATION ORGANIZING NATIONALLY AND CALIFORNIA LABOR MOVEMENT

- THE LARGEST EXPANSION OF LABOR CENTERS IN 100 HISTORY OF LABOR EDUCATION
- SIX NEW LABOR CENTERS BEING LAUNCHED: UC DAVIS, UC SANTA CRUZ, UC IRVINE, UC RIVERSIDE, UC SAN DIEGO, AND UC SANTA BARBARA
- EXPANDED RESOURCES FOR UCLA, UC BERKELEY AND UC MERCED LABOR CENTERS
- UCLA GROWING LABOR STUDIES (100 MAJORS) AND WILL BE LAUNCHING FIRST MASTERS PROGRAM IN LABOR STUDIES IN THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA
- HUGE OPPORTUNITY FOR LABOR CENTERS TO SUPPORT WORK OF CALIFORNIA LABOR MOVEMENT

- \$10 MILLION GRANT FROM U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR TO LAUNCH THREE NEW LABOR CENTERS IN MEXICO CITY AND QUERETARO
- FIRST BINATIONAL/BILINGUAL CLASS BETWEEN UCLA LABOR CENTER AND UNAM (NATIONAL AUTONOMOUS UNIVERSITY OF MEXICO)
- PAOLO MARINARO (FORMERLY WITH UCLA LABOR CENTER) IS NOW DIRECTOR OF THE SOLIDARITY CENTER WITH 38 STAFF
- KENDY RIVERA (FORMERLY WITH UCLA LABOR CENTER) IS BUILDING FIRST SOLIDARITY CENTER OFFICE IN TIJUANA
